I beg to report that I am informed by the Owner that this vessel is now classed with the Bureau Veritas.

The Special Survey was commenced afloat on the 21st December last and recommendations made to renew tank top plating etc. as previously recommended.

Extensive repairs were also recommended to the shell plating at a subsequent visit when it was obvious that the Owner did not intend to effect the necessary repairs.

A minimum of repairs have now been effected for Classification with the Bureau Veritas and shell plating thicknesses accepted by them on the waterline forward were noted by me to be about 3/16" thick.

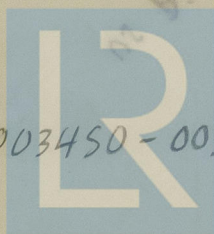
A Report 8 on this case will now be forwarded for the information of the Committee.
