With reference to your letter of the 29th ultimo in regard to the s.s."SVEABORG", I have to state that the case has been examined and the circumstances found to be as follows:-

In July 1945 this vessel came under the survey of the Society's Surveyors at Oslo for classification and for damage due to grounding and collision at Buenos Aires. The classification fees amounted to Kr.420 and this sum has been paid. The fees for the damage survey amount to Kr.350 and are still outstanding.

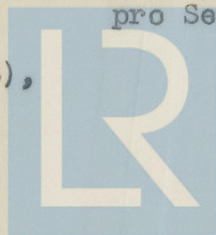
I shall be pleased to furnish any further information you may require to enable a settlement of this matter to be made.
