On 23.2.60, it being stated that the ship was laid up, the Committee agreed to the class remaining undisturbed, provided the outstanding surveys were held before the ship again proceeded to sea. The Gothenburg Surveyors advised at the end of 2.60 that the tug was to be used for harbour towing during the Summer of 1960. It was also stated that the ship would be slipped in May/June, 1960 but the Owners requested postponement of the Screwshaft Survey until the Autumn of 1960 (about 12 months after due date of Screwshaft Survey). On 4.3.60 the Gothenburg Surveyors were informed that the Committee would be prepared to agree to the Screwshaft Survey being deferred until the end of the Summer season 1960, provided all was found to be in order at the drydocking in May/June, and on the definite understanding that the ship would be employed for harbour work at Luleå only.

The Gothenburg Surveyors have been informed by the Owners that it was not possible to arrange for drydocking in May/June as previously contemplated. The Owners now request postponement of the Drydocking and Screwshaft Surveys until 12.60 (15 months after due date of Screwshaft Survey) and 30 months after last examination in drydock). The ship will proceed to the South of Sweden for survey after 30.11.60.
