With reference to my letter of the 4th March last and previous correspondence, I would inform you that the Main Boiler Survey was held on the 7th May last at Stockholm and the notation MBS 5.60 assigned.

No report has so far been received, however, that the ship has been examined whilst on the slipway for bottom painting and the screwshaft found in order for postponement of the Screwshaft Survey, due at the end of last September, until the completion of the shipping season at Lulea next Autumn, on the understanding that the vessel is employed only for harbour work at that port.

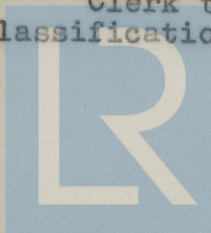
In the circumstances I shall be glad to learn, by return if possible, what is the present position regarding this case and would point out that the last recorded drydocking date is June, 1958.
