The class is subject to 135 fathoms of chain cable (p.s.) being tested at the first convenient opportunity, and to (a bower anchor being supplied).

The PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY (C) due 4.48 was commenced Cal.5.47 and advanced Cal.1.48 - 7.48 and Bal. 9.48.

TO COMPLETE S.S. :-

Examine. :-

No.4. hold, all 'tween decks, machinery spaces, D.B. feed water tank (s.s.), anchors, chain locker, steering gear, general equipment, and pumps (if any).

Test. :-

Deep tank.

The YOKOHAMA Surveyor reports this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, and repairs and strengthening effected to cracked rudder in way of previous repairs (see plan attached).

Defective shell rivets also dealt with.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed, with record of docking survey 11.48, subject as above.

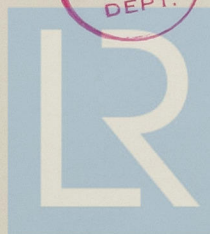
