 examined the Masts, Spars, Iron Work of same, and Rigging, of the  
 (Name of Vessel)..... "KINGSTON AGATE",

on the (Date of examination)..... 24th March, 19 50 ,

I have to report that I found FOREMAST (steel) in good condition.

Mast wedges and mast coat in good order. Shrouds in good order,  
 serving to repair, ratlines to renew.

Deadeyes in good order, lanyards to renew, p. & s.

Rods and deck eyeplates in good order, upper and lower bolts to  
 renew. Forestay, P. & S. preventer stays, foretopmast stay and  
 crews to same to renew. Eyeplates on deck in good condition.

MIZZENMAST (steel) in good condition. Chain plates, rigging screws and  
 shackles to renew. Shrouds in good order, ratlines to renew, serving  
 to repair. Quarter stays and forward preventer stays and screws and  
 shackles to renew. Deck eyeplates in good condition.

DERRICKS, starboard (steel), port (wood) in good condition.

FUNNEL stays and lanyards to renew. Ringplates in good order.
