*7160* Tons, of *Montreal P.Q.*

have been Specially Surveyed by the Surveyors to this Society during construction at *Lachine P.Q. + Vancouver B.C.*

and were reported to be on the *14<sup>th</sup> February 1944* at *Vancouver B.C.*

in good, efficient, and safe working condition, at a pressure of *250* lb. per square inch on the main <sup>W.T.</sup> boilers. The approved working pressure of the donkey boiler is *8* lb. per square inch.

The Record  LMC *244* (Lloyd's Machinery Certificate) has been made in the Register Book, subject to Periodical Surveys as required by the Rules, and to the masthead + sidelight wiring and all other P.V.C. cables fitted on deck being examined before the end of *246*.
