S.S. "CORINTHIAN".

With reference to your letter of the 18th August the report of the survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at this port last month has today received the consideration of the Scottish Sub-Committee of Classification.

The Surveyors state that a satisfactory General Examination has been carried out in drydock and afloat and that the indented shell plate J.13 on the starboard side from aft has been examined and found efficient. They recommend that this plate should be further examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking. Permanent repairs have been effected to the defective main injection valve and the Surveyors further recommend that the condition of class in respect of this item should be deleted.

The Committee have accordingly agreed to your proposal to postpone the Special Survey until October, 1963 and have assigned a fresh date of docking 9.62 subject to the above condition respecting shell plate J.13.
