20 press boilers have been fitted on main deck. These tanks ~~are~~ have been constructed in accordance with the approved plans. The steel material used in the construction has been manufactured at approved works and tested by the Society's Surveyors as per Rule.

The cast steel doors have been manufactured by Messrs. Strømmens Verksted A/S and tested as per Rule.

The boilers have been tested by hydraulic pressure to 140 lbs. per sq. inch and found tight.³ and marked :-

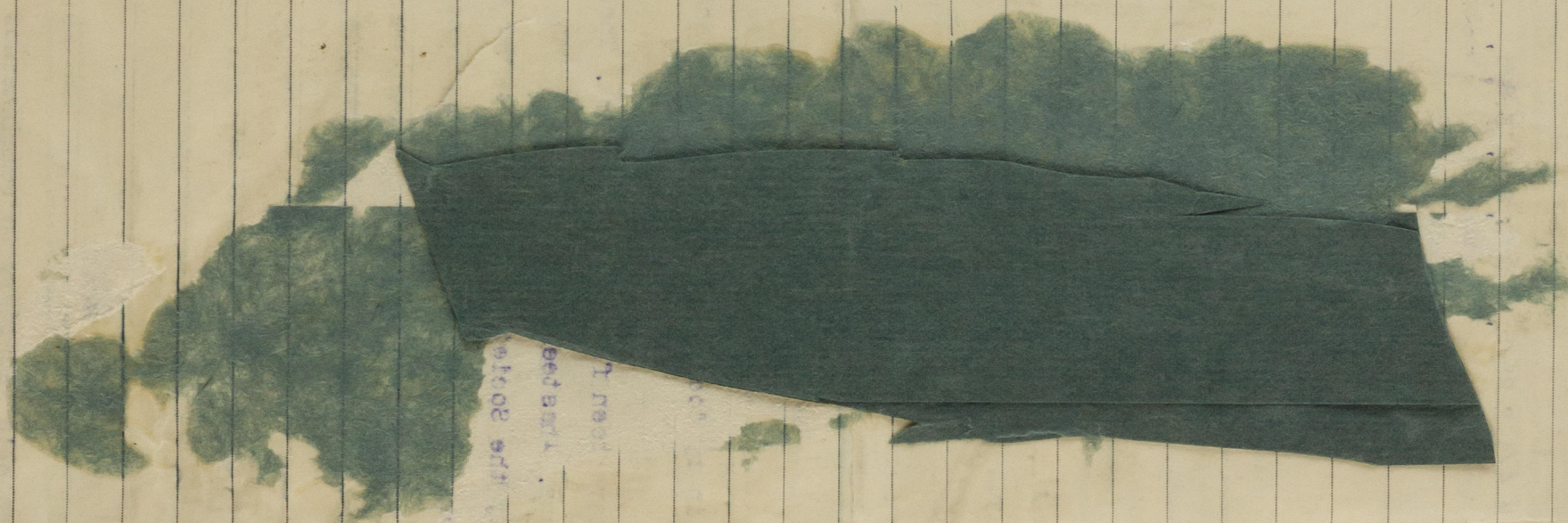
