The Helsingfors Surveyors report this vessel examined afloat and the requirements of the 2nd S.S.No.1, due 7,37, carried out with the exception of the examination in dry dock which was carried out at Tonsberg in January last. *It is submitted this part survey be accepted*

In reply to enquiry the Oslo Surveyors state that that examination in dry dock can be accepted as part of the Special Survey.

Repairs have been effected to rigging, ceiling, piping, hatchways etc. ventilators, deckhouses, bulwarks, chain locker and minor repairs carried out.

The vessel, which was converted in 1922 to carry whale oil in bulk and in 1928 to carry whale oil or other oils in bulk, has now been reconverted to an ordinary cargo vessel in accordance with approved plans and correspondence.

It is ^{further} submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 5,37 and notation of S.S.No.1-37.
