The scantlings are in accordance with approved plans for a working pressure of 70 lbs. per sq. inch. The steel materials have been tested by the Society's Surveyors.

The boilers were subsequently tested by hydraulic pressure to 110 lbs. per sq. inch and found perfectly tight and sound at that pressure.

The workmanship throughout is good.
