I duly received your letter of the 24th ultimo
relative to the classification of the steamer "ARCOS" and your
remarks of the 4th instant respecting the steamers
"ARISTICH KRASSIN" and "TOVARITSCH STALIN", and having
submitted the same for the consideration of the Committee
at their Meeting today, I am directed to acquaint you that,
in view of your intimation, instructions have been given for
the characters of these three vessels to be withdrawn from
Lloyd's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in
thereof, in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at
your request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of
these vessels' classes the records of the freeboards assigned
by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts,
will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate, in each
case, is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this
Office.
