"TOVARIATCH STALIN". The First Entry reports received from the Leningrad Surveyors were submitted to the Committee to-day and the vessel has been classed M100A1 subject to the stern frame where repaired by the electric welding process being specially examined at the next dry docking "strengthened for navigation in ice", with notations of Lloyd's A & CB, MLC 8,27 subject to the screwshaft being examined before the end of August, 1928. With reference to your letter of the 5th instant, the enclosed certificates can be handed to the Master of the vessel in accordance with a request received from the Leningrad Surveyors. As regards the freeboards I have to acquaint you that these were assigned by the Russian Register, and a certificate will not be issued by this Society.
