

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of The Central Marine Engine Works, West Hartlepool, attend at their Works on the 8th May, 1953, and subsequently, for the purpose of examining one three throw main engine crankshaft, Order No. 9829, stated to be intended for the s.s. "HARTBRIDGE".

The original MP and HP cranks were examined individually in the lathe and checked for truth, the coupling faces lightly machined and the HP crank pin "lapped".

A new LP crank stamped "Lloyd's No. 2769 K.F., J.L. 22-7-52" was then assembled together with the MP and HP cranks, the coupling bolt holes reamed and new bolts fitted, and the complete crankshaft checked in the lathe for truth and found satisfactory.
