HENRIK DANICA.—Stavanger, Nov. 23. —Danish motor vessel Henrik Danica, Greenland for Denmark, cargo fish, has grounded off Farsund and remains. Position exposed and vessel leaky; salvage vessel attending.

LL26/11/62

HENRIK DANICA. — Stavanger, Nov. 24. Motor vessel Henrik Danica reported abandoned by crew. Prospects poor, part cargo jettisoned, salvage vessel still attending. (Later) Henrik Danica now reported sunk. (See issue of Nov. 24.)

LL27/11/62

HENRIK DANICA.—Copenhagen, Nov. 25.—A report from Farsund, dated Nov. 24, states that, according to Farsund Radio, Danish motor vessel Henrik Danica has broken in two, the two parts remaining aground.—"Borsen." (See issue of Nov. 26.)

LL30/11/62

HENRIK DANICA. — Oslo, Nov. 26. — Danish motor vessel Henrik Danica, which grounded off Farsund in the night of Nov. 22-23 and subsequently broke in two, has disappeared and is thought to have slipped into deep water.—"Norges Handels og Sjøfartstidende." (See issues of Nov. 26 and 27.)
