The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

Nature of Survey _____

The 1st S.S.No.2, due 4,36, has been partly held.

The Oslo Surveyors now report the vessel placed on a floating dock, rudder pintles and gudgeons dealt with, cement laid in all double bottom tanks, a number of repairs and alterations in connexion with freeboard carried out.

The Owners desire to postpone the completion of the Special Survey until the end of the year of grace and this proposal in the Surveyors' opinion merits approval.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 4,36, and the year of grace agreed to as recommended.
