With reference to the entry in the Special Reasons List No.173, also to the Steam Pipes Survey due 3.59. and Main Boiler Survey due 11.59., attention is drawn to your memorandum of the 23rd July last. On the 5th October the Kobe Surveyors wrote that the ship had been laid up at Kasado since the 1st August. Acknowledging this information the Kobe Surveyors were informed on the 20th October that in the circumstances the Committee were agreeable to the class remaining undisturbed in the meantime, provided the outstanding surveys are dealt with before the vessel again proceeds to sea. In a memorandum dated the 26th February the Kobe Surveyors stated the vessel is still laid up at Kasado.

I shall be glad if you will advise the Owners in New York regarding the above position of this case.
