Standing Conditions of Class: SUBJECT to corrugated side shell plating (p & s) being specially examined and to sheerstrake plates Nos.1 & 2 in 1st below sheer and No.1 contour plate etc. (p.s.) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary next drydocking, also to bulkhead between Nos.4 & 5 holds (part doubled) being dealt with as necessary at the Special Survey.
