Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

With reference to the memorandum dated 25-11-41 regarding accommodation for defence personnel, this accommodation is now removed from the forecastle tween decks, and the following alterations made. ✓

- 1) Companionway removed and forecastle deck in way replated. ✓
- 2) The 6" and three 4" dia. vents on the forecastle deck removed and the openings plated over. ✓
- 3) Of four 10" dia. sidelights which were fitted on the forecastle front bulkhead, two have been removed in way of the tonnage openings. ✓
- 4) The 2" dia. washbasin discharge removed from the Port shell and the opening plated over. ✓
- 5) The two 1½" dia. flap scuppers (P & S) through the forecastle front remain. ✓

With reference to the memorandum dated 6-7-43 at Blyth, regarding one ventilator 11" dia. fitted on the Starboard side of the forecastle deck, forward of No. 1 Hatch, this ventilator is permanent to No. 1 Hold. ✓
