## Motorship "JAVA"

I duly received your letter of the 30th August and have to acquaint you that the Owners' request regarding further postponement of the Special Survey has now been considered by the Committee.

They desire me to point out that the extension of class requested is some six months beyond the expiration of the year of grace, but bearing in mind that the ship is to be scrapped on arrival at Hong Kong they have agreed to the deferment requested subject to a comprehensive General Examination being carried out in drydock and the ship being found or placed in a satisfactory condition for the proposed voyage with cargo to Bombay and thence in ballast to Hong Kong.

There are three limits outstanding against the machinery viz:-

1. Port main engine scavenge pump lower piston and rod to be examined by 8.62.
2. Windlass main drive gear to be examined by 9.62.
3. Starboard exhaust gas economiser heating coils to be examined and dealt with by 9.62.

and the Committee expect these matters to receive attention and the sternbush wear down to be found satisfactory at the General Examination.
