Motorship "JAVA"

This ship was surveyed in drydock at Calcutta in June/July last, when some repairs were carried out to the scavenge pump and to the electric windlass.

As a result of this survey a fresh record of Drydocking Survey 6.61 has now been assigned and the class has been continued subject to the port main engine scavenge pump lower piston and rod being examined by the end of August, 1962 and also to the windlass main drive gear being examined by the end of October, 1961.

In view of the fact that the Donkey Boiler Survey became due at the end of May, I shall be glad to learn what arrangements you propose making to have this survey carried out.
