Dear Sirs,

S. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letters of the 19th ultimo respecting the Steamer "ESSO BIRMINGHAM", and in reply to your enquiries have to inform you that agreement was reached with the Owners for an inclusive fee of £300 to be charged in this case.

It must be explained that of this sum, the proportion due for the Hull Survey has previously been charged, and accordingly no account in respect of the advancement of the Classification Special Survey now carried out, should be rendered. The fees of £29 for General Examination and £8 for Freeboard Survey are, however, approved.

In regard to machinery, it is considered you should charge £48 for the survey now held, which, under the arrangement mentioned above, will leave a balance of £50 to be collected on completion of the Machinery and Electrical Classification Surveys. ✓
