" Total fee for full classification "excluding freeboard" to be £300, this sum to include General Examination fees paid up to the time the special survey for classification becomes due (1948 in this case) and to be inclusive of hull, Machinery, boilers and electrical equipment.

Rule fees - Hull = twice S.S.(B) = £171
Machinery (Electric Propulsion) = £140

Of the hull fee of £166 the following has already been charged.

Part Classification Survey Liverpool July 1947 = £150
Total - £171

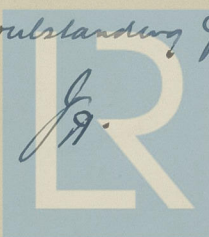
Therefore, nothing remains outstanding on hull classification fee.
