Dear Sir,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "IRON BARON", which vessel is at present laid up at Amsterdam, I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at that port have forwarded to this Office a communication, signed by the Master of the ship, intimating that you have decided not to continue the vessel's classification with this Society.

The Committee have had the case before them at their meeting today, and I am directed to state that, in the circumstances, instructions have been given for the character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof in withdrawal of class at Owner's request.

I have to add that in view of the vessel's class the record of the Committee, together with the certificate, should be withdrawn and the freeboard should be returned to this Office.
