This is to Certify *that I have*

Surveyed the S/S "JOHN JACOB ASTOR" 7176 tons gross of Bombay whilst afloat and on dry dock at Todd Galveston Dry Docks, Inc. on the 19th February, 1947 and subsequent dates for Docking, full Special Survey for Classification in the Society's Register Book, Removal of Defense Measures and Repairs,

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and

that I have Recommended that she be classed in the Society's Register Book viz. 100A1 with notation now of Docking Date 3.47 and S.S. Gal. No. 1-47 (Special Survey No. 1 Galveston, March 1947), subject to shaft tunnel W. T. door to operate from bulkhead deck, and permanent repair to double bottom tank top in No. 5 hold starboard side first opportunity, also 150 fathoms of cable to supply first opportunity,

being fit to carry dry and perishable cargoes.
