
In reply to your letter F of 8th ultimo respecting the steamer "JALAKANYA" I beg to state that this steamer is now in port and the bearing surface for the hatch covers and spacing of hatch coaming stays have been checked and found to agree with these shown in the sketch enclosed with my letter of the 8th ultimo.

As the Load Line Certificate for this vessel had expired the vessel was examined generally and a Provisional Certificate issued valid for six months.

With reference to your letter F of the 25th ultimo regarding the equipment of this vessel I beg to state that the markings on the anchors have been verified and found to agree with the Certificates on board.
