The scantlings of this "C" Type Standard Ship have been approved for a draught of 30" in excess of that corresponding to the freeboard which could be assigned as a C.S.S. vessel having a tonnage opening.

The tank top plating has been increased in thickness under hatchways in lieu of ceiling.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed ~~8100A1~~ "With freeboard"

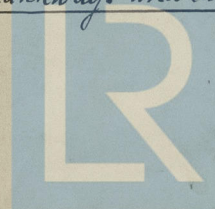
