

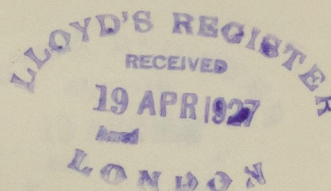

Tunnel Well One 3" dia.

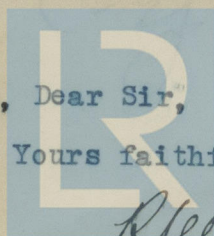
The spare^{feet} supplied was in accordance with the Rules' requirements and the list given.
