

## REPORT ON MASTS, SPARS, AND RIGGING.

Having, in accordance with your instructions,  
examined the Masts, Spars, Iron Work of same, and Rigging, of the  
(Name of Vessel) Twin Screw Steamer "Sula"  
on the (Date of examination) 22nd January, 2nd, 8th & 9th February, 1952.  
I have to report that I found Cargo brocks, shackles, pins, riggings  
& their screws, dead eyes and other fittings on fore & aft masts  
and Samson posts, were overhauled, adjusted and found or now placed  
in good condition.

Five rungs on fore mast ladder and six rungs on aft, repaired.

No. 6 port derrick post top part, renewed.
