Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in JULY, 1932.

The following additional air pipes have been fitted in consequence
of a re-arrangement of double bottom tanks for carrying oil fuel.

2 W.I. airpipes on bridge dk. 24" high x 4" dia. from No. 4 DB oil fuel tank

1 " " " " " " " x 2½" " "cofferdam between No. 4

for'd and No. 4 aft DB tanks

1 " " " upper dk aft 36" high x 2½" dia., from cofferdam

between No. 6 and No. 7 DB tanks.

All air pipes from DB tanks which carry oil fuel viz: Nos. 2, 3, 4

for'd 7 and 8 now fitted with wire gauzes. Canvas covers provided

for new cofferdam air pipes.

Hinged shutters on freeing ports as given on original Rpt. C. 11

no longer fitted. Protection bars on these openings are efficient.
