In reply to your letter of the 20th instant referring to our Report No.17668, Boiler D.491, fitted to the Steam Trawler "LOCH OSKAIG", we have to state that the heating surface given on the report, viz:- 2688 sq. ft. is correct, and not 2720 sq. ft. shown on the plan as originally approved.

In this connexion we would refer to our letter of the 7th December, 1936, enclosing a plan showing proposed amendment to the lower rows of tubes for Boilers D.491 & D.492, which plan was approved in your letter of the 11th December, 1936. A copy of the drawing referred to is enclosed herewith.

The superheater draining arrangements were fitted by the engine builders, and a copy of your letter has now been forwarded to the Middlesbrough Surveyors requesting them to reply direct to you.
