Holden & Brooke, Ltd., of Manchester attend at their Works on the 8th March, 1930, for the purpose of inspecting and testing one Marine Type High Velocity Exhaust Steam Feed Water Heater No. 1194, made to the Order No. 9957 of 7-1-30 of Messrs. Smith's Dock Co. Ltd., South Bank-on-Tees.

The heater was examined and, so far as could be seen, was of sound material and good workmanship.

The tubes, headers and distributing valves chest were, in the presence of the undersigned, tested by hydraulic pressure to 400 pounds per square inch, and the casing to 30 pounds per square inch, with satisfactory results.

The heater is stamped for identification:- "TESTED LLOYDS 6-3-30, J.M.R. *R*, (water ends & valves chest) 400 LBS., (casing) 30 LBS".
