I duly received your letter of the 23rd October and in reply would explain that the class of this ship was cancelled by the Committee on the 5th June by the assignment of a notation "To be Broken Up". In arriving at this decision the Committee were not aware of my letter to you on 27th May, and when attention was drawn to that correspondence it was decided to defer entering in the Supplement until September the notation "To be broken up".

It was of course hoped that the ship would have arrived in Japan by that time, and that no embarrassment might arise out of the conflicting decisions.

It is now noted that the vessel still remains at Rotterdam, and it was therefore perfectly correct for you to remind the Owners that the agreement contained in my letter of the 27th May no longer exists.
