The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/62.)

The class is subject to shell plate B.4 (p.s.f) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the Special Survey.

There is an entry in the S.R.L. Appendix.

A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 6,60 but the ship has been laid up since May, 1958, consequently the Notation of "Laid Up - Surveys Overdue 6,60" was recorded in the Register Book on the 13th July, 1961.

The OSLO Surveyors report (8,61) the ship examined afloat and found in a satisfactory condition to be towed as an "Hulk" to Spain where she is to be broken up.
