S.S. "PAN OCEAN"

I have to acknowledge receipt of your letters "S" dated the 6th and 20th of June, 1950.

Regarding the former, I have to advise you that the steering gear and its engine, auxiliary steering gear and spares, windlass and its engine have now been specially examined and my report has been despatched herewith.

With reference to diminuation on "K" & "L" Strakes amidships, it must be stated that the "N" Strakes port and starboard are fitted with efficient riveted doublings from fore end of the bridge on frame 140 to abreast the main mast on frame No.37 the doublings are .65" in thickness, and should I believe, provide ample compensation for the loss in shell thicknesses.

I was most pleased to receive a definite ruling on the outstanding shell fire damage, and this decision has been communicated to the Owner.

The vessel is now at Alexandria discharging, and it is understood that shell repairs port and starboard sides will commence shortly.
