Subject to permanent repairs to shell plates port side K.20, M 15 & 16 and N 11, 12 and 13 upon return to Alexandria from present contemplated voyage to the Black Sea.

Deep tank not to be used for Oil Fuel, until girders fitted to tank top and extended spindles to suction valves.
