SUBJECT to indented shell plates 1st strake below sheer No.13 (p.s. from fwd) (E.W. and doubled 10,57), G.6 and F.5 & 6 (s.s. from fwd) and H.5 (p.s. from fwd), and fractured shell plate C.2 (p.s.a) (locally doubled 1,59) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary, also to rudder mainpiece (E.W.1,59) being specially examined, next drydocking.
