

Motorship "NYLON"

This vessel ran aground in September and broke in two. The after part of the vessel was towed from St. Abb's to Newcastle where it has remained since 28th November.

Mr. Irwin has telephoned this morning stating that he understands he will be asked to issue a Certificate stating that the after portion is, in his opinion, fit to be towed to Germany where a new forward end will be built on.

He will be glad to know whether he will be authorised to undertake this work.
