Steamer "AVISMERE"

With reference to my telephone conversation with Captain Campbell yesterday, I beg to acquaint you that I have been in communication with the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle in regard to their recommendations for intercostal stiffeners to the buckled bottom plating and additional longitudinal girders to be fitted to the wavy deck plating by March next. Their opinion is that this work should be carried out by March if possible, but that this period may be extended to July, should you specially desire.

I shall therefore be obliged if you will kindly return the certificate already issued to you, so that the case may be again submitted to the Committee with a view to the assignment of a notation of "Examined 9.47" valid for ten months, i.e. until the end of July 1948, should it be your wish to postpone the necessary repairs until that time.
