Sirs,

With reference to your Report No.104761 on the steamer "ISMERE" ex "OCEAN VISION", Captain Booth, the Owners' Superintendent, called at this Office on the 14th instant with J. Taylor their Consulting Engineer.

Mr. Taylor stated his understanding of the case was that you had recommended that the additional stiffening necessary could be carried out before the end of March 1948 and that, in his opinion, this work was essential by that date.

Seeing, however, that you recommended a record of "examined 9,47." with 12 months validity, for which a certificate was granted, there seems to be some conflict of opinion in the minds of the Owners in the matter. I have accordingly to request that you will clarify the position.
