MABROUK. — Casablanca, Sept. 13. —
 Trawler Mabrouk reported sunk on
 Sept. 12 near Nice.
 — Marseilles, Sept. 14. —
 Motor tanker Sudest, from Leghorn,
 arrived at Marseilles yesterday with 14
 survivors of Moroccan trawler Mabrouk,
 which had sunk off Nice. The survivors
 had been found in two lifeboats 30 miles
 south-east of La Garoupe. The Mabrouk,
 of Casablanca, with 100 tons of frozen
 fish, sank owing to leakage. —
 "L'Antenne."

MABROUK. — London, Oct. 13. — In reply
 to inquiry, Lloyd's Agents at Marseilles
 write under date of Oct. 10: Trawler
 Mabrouk foundered in position lat. 43 22
 N., long. 7 48 E., after the vessel had
