## Lloyd's Register of Shipping

Dear Sir,

I have to inform you that the new s.s. "SLIGO" - Dublin Dockyard Co's Yard No.146 - has proceeded to your port with a view to the installation of the machinery.

To complete the survey the following remains to be done :- Machinery casings, deck plating, boiler stools and sheathing etc., left loose for shipping machinery, to be replaced, riveted and caulked. Bridge deck and upper deck to be hose tested before "DEKFELT" is laid. Lower section of engine room bulkhead and watertight door to be hose tested. Steering gear and windlass to be tested under working conditions, bilge and ballast pumping arrangements to test throughout, Nos. 3 & 4 double bottom tanks to be water tested in way of fasteners of main and auxiliary machinery.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be so good as to arrange for the Surveyors to give the case the necessary attention, and, on completion of the work, to forward a report on form No.8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
