SHIPS NAME Oil Tanker "OMIROS" REPORT - No. -

The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/62.)

This ship was built in 1927 and is classed:-

100A1 "Carrying Homogeneous Cargoes of Petroleum in Bulk between Cofferdams".

The class is subject to the sternframe (E.W.6,55) being specially examined at next drydocking.

A SPECIAL SURVEY became due 10,56.

The ship is presently laid up at Hamburg and a notation of "Laid Up - Surveys Overdue 10,56" is recorded in the Register Book.

The Owners' Agents at Hamburg state (20.3.59) that it is not known when the ship will be put into service again.

In accordance with instructions to delete "Homogeneous Cargoes" from the class of ships IT IS SUBMITTED the class be amended to 100A1 "Oil Tanker", subject to the intermediate bulkheads being dealt with as necessary at the Special Survey, and as above.
