The Second Special Survey No.1 became due on these trawlers: 7,32, 4,32 and 6,32, respectively, and postponements have been granted, in each case, by the Classing Committee.

In reply to enquiry the Aberdeen Surveyors now forward a letter addressed to them by the Owner requesting that, for reasons of economy, these three vessels be withdrawn from the Society's classification.

The years of grace expired: 7,33, 4,33 and 6,33, respectively, and the Classing Committee, who had the cases before them on Friday, 1st instant, decided in the circumstances to give instructions for the class of each vessel to be expunged with a Red Line (9.33), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owner has been informed accordingly.
