Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

Restoring of Tonnage Opening.

- (1) The tonnage opening in the Shelter Deck now restored and fitted with temporary wood covers. (Cleats to be removed from B.A. Coaming of Tonnage Hatch on Shelter Deck).
- (2) The tonnage opening on the Tonnage Well forward bulkhead now closed by 3" boards fitted in Channels.
- (3) All scuppers which are led to the Hold Bilges from the Shelter Tween Decks now permanently closed by E.W. plates.
- (4) An overboard scupper 5" in diameter fitted on each side of the Tonnage Well with a screw-down automatic non-return valve controlled from the Shelter Deck with an indicator showing when valve is open or shut.
- (5) All hatchways on the 2nd Deck have coamings, covers, supports, bearing surfaces, tarpaulins, cleats and battening arrangements in accordance with Rules.
