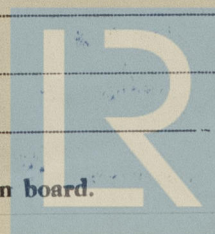
ALTERATIONS TO CONDITIONS OF ASSIGNMENT OF LOADLINES

Ship's Name S.S. "LODESTONE"Official No. 166585.Port of Registry LondonThis ship has been under survey at London and Tilbury,on July 26th 1956 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been ~~effected~~/found:—

A tunnel escape companionway leading from the engine well has been erected on the starboard side of the weather deck adjacent the tonnage hatch. An opening 24 in. x 24 in. cut in weather deck stringer plate with efficient deck doublers in way. Companionway of substantial steel all-welded construction with sill 22 in. high and fitted with hinged steel door secured by toggles operable both sides.
