Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

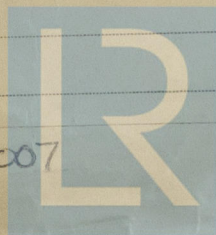
Hatch covers in shelter 'tween decks found deficient and permit for new covers refused.

As a temporary measure the access openings in the forward bulkhead of the tonnage well have been plated over (bolted and nuts welded on) and securing plates have been welded over the existing screw plugs in the overboard scuppers. Two scuppers have been fitted each side to the machinery space bilges and there is clear drainage to these from all parts of the 'tween decks.
