Caird & Rayner, Ltd., 777, Commercial Road, London, E.14., attend at their works on the 7th September, 1933, and subsequently, for the purpose of surveying a welded steel shell two stage feed water heater No.1077 for Messrs. Smith Dock Co's. Yard No.427.

The heaters have been manufactured in accordance with plans approved on the 24th May, 1933, for working pressures as follows:-  
20 lbs. per square inch in lower shell.  
70 lbs. per square inch in upper shell.  
225 lbs. per square inch in the water spaces.

The heaters have been examined under the following approved hydraulic test pressures:-  
100 lbs. per square in. lower shell.  
200 lbs. per square in. upper shell.  
450 lbs. per square in. water spaces,  
and  
in the presence of the undersigned, and found sound/tight at these pressures.
