the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners representative, attend on board the Steel Motor Vessel "Y A N D R A", 1125 tons gross, whilst lying afloat in the River Thames on the 5th and 7th September, 1928, for the purpose of surveying defective fastenings of rudder-head stuffing box (cause not stated).

FOUND :- Fastenings of stuffing box and chocks started.

RECOMMENDED :- Crescent chocks at port and starboard sides of stuffing box to be removed and replaced by square chocks extending beyond doubling and secured to the deck by fitted bolts. Saddle blocks to be fitted at sides of stuffing box, and tapered keys to be fitted between saddle blocks and chocks.

The above repairs were recommended with a view to placing the steering gear and rudder in good and efficient condition.

Fee :- £2-2-0.

Expenses :- 18/6.
