47511 "LYLEPARK" - As recommended. I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 18th instant, the contents of which have been noted.

"NUSAKAN" - I shall be glad if you will request the Owners to state whether they desire the machinery of this ship to be examined on the Continuous Survey basis.

"KAIS" - In view of the satisfactory nature of the General Examination now carried out at Sorong, the Committee have agreed to postponement of the Special Survey until October, 1959, and I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.

47347 "MARVA" - This ship has today been classed #100A1 together with the appropriate notations recommended by you.

I shall be glad if you will forward copies of the forging certificates for the sternframe and rudder, as these do not appear to have accompanied your report as stated.

47360 "REDWIJS ZII" - The contents of your report and letter of the 5th ultimo have been noted. The Committee have decided not to amend the class, but have given instructions for the notation "To be broken up" to be recorded in the Register Book, when the ship has arrived in Japan.
